He is one of the most outstanding artists
of contemporary abstraction.

At the beginning of the eighties

He managed to regain abstract painting the ability to move.

His work condenses a great understanding of the history of art, and stands out above all for his pictorial technique,
which is characterized by a combination
of unique colors and shades of great depth
that fill his abstract compositions with warmth.

«[...] I would like my work to be expressed through the universal language of rhythm.

The rhythm communicates in a primitive, direct way through feelings.

If you look at my paintings, you will appreciate different rhythms:

fast or slow in different fragments of the same painting."

Scully's work has changed the world of abstraction and is open to all kinds of interpretations.

It often inspires a deep introspective and contemplative state.

The simplicity and repetition of his compositions create visual rhythm,

where lines, stripes and blocks vibrate with life and emotion through the brushstrokes.

With his compositions the artist can evoke emotions in each person who contemplates them.

The exhibition "Sean Scully", curated by Javier Molins, offers a retrospective view of the artist's work over more than six decades of production, from the first figurative pieces of the sixties, going through the minimalist stage of the seventies, until we reach the return of emotion to abstract painting.

The exhibition includes more than sixty works between paintings, sculptures, drawings and photographs. The exhibition is organized chronologically, and highlights Scully's eagerness to renew the understanding of abstraction.

According to the artist himself, he wants to "reflect the human spirit within the grid of our world".
